domestic violence program

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## GUARDIANSHIP

**Guardianship for Seniors** serves adult Mahoning County residents, age 55 and over, considered by Mahoning County Probate Court to be at risk for neglect, abuse, or exploitation due to cognitive impairment. COMPASS Guardians are court-appointed and provide ongoing assistance in the least restrictive living environment. Guardians ensure that clients receive proper care and essential services to promote healthy living. An assessment is used to determine if guardianship services are recommended.

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## RAPE CRISIS

and counseling center

**Rape Crisis and Counseling Center** serves sexual assault survivors in Mahoning County. Survivors and their families receive counseling, advocacy, and can participate in support groups, as well as have support during a hospital rape-crisis exam. All ages are served and are available free of charge, 24 hours a day.

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## WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

**Workforce Development** services helps unemployed or underemployed individuals connect with job training and employment. Specialized services are available to individuals with disabilities such as mental illness and addiction who can benefit from our individualized career and wrap around support services. Local employers are also engaged for their expertise and hiring capability. COMPASS' Workforce Development services promote recovery, dignity, and self-dependence while helping to resolve the community's economic need for good workers.

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## BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

mental health and addictions

**Behavioral Health** services provide individuals and families with necessary support, interventions, and treatment for success. Services are designed to address mental health and addictions through outpatient counseling, prevention services, crisis intervention, intensive outpatient, and case management. Psychiatric services and medication management are provided by a specialized, psychiatric medical team of doctors and nurses. Assisting those with Co-Occurring Disorders is a specialty. Short-term and long-term support is available.

Residential Services aim to provide a therapeutic environment within which individuals with behavioral health disorders can achieve their highest level of independence, stability, and life satisfaction. This supportive, residential care is client-driven and sees the person first and the disability second. Crisis Stabilization is also offered.

Services are available in both Mahoning and Trumbull Counties.
