Hello. This is Dr. Thomas with a follow-up announcement.

As a follow-up to this afternoon's all-call, please understand that the administration and Lowellville Police immediately responded to the allegation yesterday evening and addressed the situation. Rest assured, with the information we received yesterday evening, the awareness of the situation including communication with the parties involved, and the student not being in school, there was no imminent threat or the need to cancel school or make a late evening all-call.

Today, in collaboration with the Lowellville Police Department, the administration investigated the source of the allegation and found it to be not accurate. Although, the investigation did uncover additional information that was addressed. As a District, it is the responsibility to address student discipline confidentially; student discipline is not allowed by law to be discussed publicly or communicated by the school. Respectively, if the situation would have warranted a cancellation of school, we would have hedged on the side of safety first.

The Lowellville District puts student and staff safety at the top of its priority list, does not tolerate threats, and administers discipline based upon District policy.

Again, thank you for your diligence to report suspicious behavior in an effort to keep everyone safe.
