

**ALL-CALL
November 13, 2020 (3:30 p.m.)**

Hello. This is Dr. Thomas with an important announcement. Today, we received communication that a cafeteria staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This is the second COVID positive this week; the girls' basketball program had a positive COVID test.

The entire cafeteria staff will have to go into quarantine including others who had regular contact with her. Unfortunately, this will not allow Lowellville to have food service. Also, with the staff that works both in the cafeteria and provides transportation and due to other previous factors, Lowellville will be without several drivers which will impede us from providing transportation.

Nevertheless, we are contacting the health department for contact tracing and will begin remote learning MODEL ONE (HOME) for grades K-12 on Monday, November 16th with a plan to return to in-person MODEL ONE (OPEN CAMPUS) on December 1st. Students that are enrolled on MODEL TWO will remain in the online model. We will evaluate the situation daily and notify you of any changes.

Finally, teachers will put together learning packets for students in grades K-2 and for any other students that were absent today, both groups can come and pick up their learning packets, textbooks and materials between the hours of 1:00 – 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 16th. NOTE: K-2 will not participate in “live” remote learning due to a shortage of computers.
